Come join us for three days of fun in the sun! Meet highlights include an approximately 100-mile plaque tour along the scenic Kern River via California City into Historic Tehachapi. Tour stops in Tehachapi will include local railroad and history museums and the world-renowned Tehachapi Loop, a railroad engineering marvel which permits rail traffic from the Mojave Desert to the San Joaquin Valley. We will also tour the West Kern County Oil Museum and learn about Bakersfield's rich oil exploration and production history. The meet will kick off with the traditional Ice Cream Social and we will have an opportunity to enjoy the Chevrolets at our Show and Shine. Our time together will culminate with a wonderful evening dinner banquet.

There is a special show rate of \$45 per night which is also good for the day before the show and day after the show (May 15th through the 19th). **\*Although you need to reserve directly with the RV Park, please pay your RV Park reservation fees with this event registration. We will forward your payment to the RV Park on the day of check in.**

Please note you may cancel your camping reservation up to May 1st and be refunded your camping fees, but after May 1st you will lose your first night fee. If you cancel May 8th or after you will lose your entire fee for every night reserved. All 15 sites reserved for our show are pull through.
